The LGU shall ensure the animal welfare inspection, ante-mortem and post-mortem inspection, daily monitoring of hygiene and sanitation, pest and disease surveillance, issuance of meat and meat product inspection certificate, collection of inspection fees and charges and a post-meat establishment control.
